DEPUTY COMMISSIONER REVIEWED CIC PROJECT

North Lakhimpur 23rd December 2005 A review meeting was held today dated 23rd December in the Conference hall of the office of the Deputy Commissioner under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Lakhimpur and attended by GM DICC, DIO NIC, various officials of Industries Departments , CIC operators and several SHGs constituted by students of CIC.

At the outset the review, it was found that the revenue earned and students passed out from various CICs are as follows, Narayanpur (Rs 1,51,280 , 303 Nos), Bihpuria (Rs 98,560, 215 Nos) , Karunabari (Rs 79175 , 151 Nos) , Nowboicha (Rs 91,800 , 170 Nos) , Telahi (Rs 87800, 91 Nos) , Lakhimpur (Rs 138270 , 225 Nos), Baginodi (Rs 95326, 128 Nos), Ghilamara (Rs 65092 , 110 Nos) and Dhakuakhana (Rs 88330 , 120 Nos) . The various courses offered in the CICs are 3 months & 6 months computer Diploma, 3 months DTP course, Web designing etc. It was instructed to introduce 1 year PG Diploma course immediately in all CICs.

Deputy Commissioner Sri Mansih Thakur IAS instructed all CICs to improve performance incorporating additional services to make CIC indispensable to the society. He instructed all CICs to gear up with procuring telephone, scanner, digital camera etc to provide phone –in-services and fax facility to the public. The digital camera should be utilized to capture the various activities of the block and to upload to the website. He informed that after the introduction of Right of Information Act, every information should be made public and CIC should take pivotal role to make information available through their block website. Replying to members of SHGs on their employment opportunities, DC informed that it has been planned to provide computers to SHG of all Panchayat who will work in the Panchayat level under RSVY next phase. He told that there is no dearth of employment opportunity for technical persons and advised the SHGs to develop their skill as plenty opportunities are coming in rural areas and small towns.

Speaking the occasion, Sri Bashing GM, DICC advised all CICs to put more thrust on the entrepreneurship development of their students and instructed to organize workshop on "Entrepreneurship development and awareness camp on ASHA project" from the next January 2006 involving line departments, block office, Financial Institutions, GP/AP/ZP members, NGOs, SHG etc. without fail.

Sri Dibyajit Dutta , DIO NIC advised CICs to concentrate on producing skill manpower who can be involved in several IT projects coming up to the district. He suggested that the various sophisticated equipments and resources procured under RSVY project may be utilized by these students to earn their livelihood.

Later all the members of the SHGs attended video conferencing room and interacted with DIO, Nagaon on the various topics related with technology.
